Basil Varieties

Batik Basil

Classic basil flavor and aroma
Soups, salads, curries
Prominent, burgundy-purple flower spikes,
lighter violet flowers
Later-flowering

Chinese sweet basil

Lemony orange-flavor
Soups, stir-fries, and salads
Attractive to pollinators
Fast growing, heat tolerant
Height: 18-24"

Genovese Basil

Legendary heirloom basil
Classic flavor, used in tomato-based dishes,
sauces, pizzas, and pesto
Companion plant for tomatoes, peppers,
oregano, and marigold

Italian Large Leaf Basil

Strong Genovese-like aroma and flavor
Use for pesto and wherever basil is called for
Slow to bolt
Leaves up to 4" long
Height: up to 30"

Cardinal Basil

Spicy-sweet leaves with edible flower heads
Salads, soups, curries, fit for Mexican and
Asian dishes
Huge purple flower heads are great in flower
arrangements and attractive to pollinators

Everleaf Lemon Basil

Bright lemon flavor
Upright, densely packed, bright green glossy
leaves
Great in flower arrangements
Slow-bolting, productive, later to flower
Height: 20-24"

Greek Basil

Classic basil flavor
Pairs well with tomatoes in salads and sauces
Tiny leaves on a compact, dome-shaped plant
Ornamental in containers and gardens
Height: 8"

Kapoor Tulsi (Holy Basil) Basil

Unique, spicy aroma with hints of coffee and
chocolate
Culinary and tea uses
Compact, full plant
Purple flowers attractive to pollinators and
great in cut-flower arrangements
Height: 12-18"

Lettuce Leaf Basil

Sweet, mild flavor
Great in pesto, fragrant salads, or in place of lettuce in a lettuce wrap
Boasts distinctive, crinkled 6" leaves

Monteverde Late Flowering Basil

Rich flavor
Use wherever basil is called for
Tall, sturdy plant with small, cupped leaves
Later-flowering variety, resists downy mildew
Height: 28-32"

Siam Queen Thai Basil

Strong, clove scent
Bold, licorice-anise flavor
Wonderful in curries and Thai dishes
Compact with large, beautiful flower-heads

Sweet Thai Basil

Intense, spicy basil flavor with notes of clove and anise
Flavorful garnish for sweet dishes
Attractive purple stems and blooms
Height 16-20"

Mammolo Basil

Italian Genovese basil aroma and flavor, without typical mint smell and flavor
Pesto, pasta sauces, soups, garnishes
Bred to have high leaf-to-stem ratio
Compact, bushy growth habit

Purple Ball Basil

Fragrant, tasty
Purple foliage retained in full sun
Round form
Height: 11"

Spicy Saber Basil

Spicy flavor and scent
Compact, bushy form
Unique, bright green serrated leaves
Lovely edible ornamental
